

Cumberland Bridge Project

The Government is planning to officially open the recently rehabilitated Cumberland main bridge in the latter part of March 2018. The ceremony will be hosted by the Ministry of Works, at the bridge, and will feature an interesting program. The keynote speaker will be Doctor the Honourable Ralph Gonsalves, Prime Minister of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. Other officials, including High level Representatives from the Republic of Mexico and the United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS) are expected to address the ceremony.



This new bridge replaces the former, forty-year old Bailey Bridge.

The official ground breaking ceremony signalling the start of construction took place on Thursday 20th October 2016. The project was financed by a grant from the Government of the Republic of Mexico totalling five million United States Dollars. Project Implementation was led by the UNOPS, and the contractor was Trinidad Contractors Ltd.
